Pirates : Overview

<p><u>Literacy</u> Drama: Children will impersonate pirates to understand their way of living to help with all areas of writing. Letters: Children will learn the formal of letters and whether they are formal or informal. Children will use key vocabulary to write a letter in role.</p> <p>Diaries: As we move through the topic children will write diary entries as if they were a pirate using key words and new vocabulary. They will include thought and emotions in their writing.</p> <p>Instructions: Link to Art/DT children will write instructions of how to make a pirate hat and/ or pirate jacket. They will also write about the pirate code and instructions for a treasure map.</p> <p>Factual Writing: Children will differentiate between fact and fiction They will write facts about Black Beard, Anne Bonny and Mary Read.</p> <p>Weekly diary writing with specific success criteria, phonics, reading, spelling, grammar and handwriting on going.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u> Year 1 Doubling, halving, time, shape and data. Addition, subtraction and number recognition/counting on going. .</p> <p>Year 2: 2D shape and data handling, weight and time, multiplication and division, capacity</p> <p>Addition and subtraction on going.</p>	<p><u>Geography/History</u> Children will learn and recognise the features of a map, they will learn how to use a key and will an introduction to simple atlases. They will compare old and new maps and discuss any differences. They will ask geographical and historical questions.</p> <p>They will recognise and understand that different things happened at different times in the past.</p> <p><u>Science</u> Children will learn about different everyday materials and their purpose.
