Summer Term



We have Jolly Phonics songs and actions daily and this helps to prepare us for the work we will be doing when we go into the Reception class.

We will be listening to different sounds, singing, reading stories, playing musical instruments, showing our friends things that we have made, sharing our experiences by talking about things we observe and things we have been doing. Many of these activities involve aspects of phase one phonics.

Nursery children will be playing and exploring cooperatively both indoors and outdoors to develop their personal, social, emotional and physical development supported by nursery staff. Their curiosity about the world around them and why some things happen will be encouraged as well as their ability to talk about things both past and present.

Maths in nursery is taught during the everyday business of the children's play and exploration.

We will also be singing songs which is a good way for children to become familiar with counting. We don't worry if they choose the same songs again and again because it is the familiarity with number patterns that are important.
