- Self-Confidence and Self-Awareness Show confidence in asking adults for help.
- Managing Feelings and Behaviour:
   Become aware of own feelings and know that some words and actions can hurt others' feelings.

### Literacy

- Reading: Handle books carefully.
- Look at books independently.
- Join in with repeated refrains.
- Show interest in illustration and print in books.
- Writing: Give meaning to marks as they draw and paint.

## Communication & Language

- Listening and attention: Listening to stories with increasing attention.
- Follow directions
- Understanding: Show understanding of prepositions.

**Speaking:** Use talk to connect ideas, explain what is happening and anticipate what might happen next.

# Understanding of the World

- People and Communities: Know some of the things that make them unique.
