<u>Personal, Social & Emotional</u> <u>Development</u>

- Making Relationships: Play in a group, extending and elaborating play ideas..
- Self-Confidence and Self-Awareness: Have confidence to talk to other children when playing , and communicate freely about own home and community.
- Managing Feelings and Behaviour: Tolerate delay when needs are not immediately met, and understand wish may not always be met.

<u>Literacy</u>

- **Reading:** Know that print carries meaning and is read L to R and top to bottom
- Recognise familiar words and signs such as own name and advertising logo.
- Writing: Give meaning to marks as they draw and paint.
- Ascribe meaning to marks that they see in different places

Communication & Language

- Listening and attention: Listening to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- Focus attention continue after distraction.
- Understanding: Begin to understand 'Why' and 'How' questions.
- Speaking: Question why things happen give explanations.
- Build up vocabulary that reflects the breadth of their experiences.
